Minutes of General Meeting Sept 14th 1926 [see page 51,52 of Minute Book]

Minutes of previous meeting were read and confirmed.

Correspondence was read and received.

Proposed Mr Solomon, Seconded Mr Taylor, that matter of stamp agency be left in President's hands. Carried

Proposed Mr Fisher, Seconded Mr Gilchrist, that proposed lamp near laneway in Second Avenue will not provide sufficient light if erected upon existing and it would need to be shifted if vacant lot at corner be built upon, also that Willoughby Council request City Council to try out a fluted shade. Carried

Proposed Mr Solomon, Seconded Mrs Griffin, that matter of Kindergarten be left in the hands of the Kindergarten committee. Carried

Proposed Mr Solomon, Seconded Mr Borrie, that Executive Committee recommendations to Council be adopted. Carried

Mrs S D Phillips and Mrs Lopez were admitted as members.

Proposed Mr Taylor, Seconded Mr Borrie, (Notice of Motion having been given) that "President shall not occupy the chair two years in succession". On the question being put the motion was lost.

Proposed Mr Borrie, Seconded Mr Taylor, that Council's attention be drawn to unsuitable water-tables in Edinburgh Road with a request that they be made efficient. Carried

Proposed Mr Taylor, Seconded Mr Guy, that Secretarial services for Annual meeting the work accomplished by this Association

Proposed Mr Benson, Seconded Mr Moffat, that Willoughby Council be asked to give this Association information as to how far they gone in the matter of having the Local Government Act as to straying stock, amended. Carried

Mr Taylor gave information about new boating club.
