Apology was made for the absence due to illness of Mrs Solomon.

Minutes of previous meeting of the Executive were read, received, and confirmed.

The following further donations to the recently held Xmas Party were reported: Mr Griffing £1; Mr R Forsyth 10/-; Mrs C Lafton 5/-; Mrs May Crispettes.

Special mention was made of the excellent work done for the entertainment by Miss Lightfoot, Miss McLachlan, and Mrs Pearce.

The following suggestions were made to be kept in mind for the next Christmas Party, 1927:-

- a) That the people and children be seated in rows for the distribution of ice cream and other refreshments, Boy Scouts and the Executive to act as waiters.
- b) That the children be formed into line according to size, the smallest to be served first, and no child to be served who has got out of his or her proper place in the line.
- c) That ice cream be served behind some sort of a counter
- d) The ice cream be served inside some building, waiters to carry it to visitors.
- e) That the names of children to receive presents be arranged alphabetically, and called in that order to avoid confusion and to allow whole families to receive their presents at the same time, one after the other.
- f) That no child receive the same kind of present he or she received at the 1926 party.
- g) That some covering be put over the seats to make them softer.

It was reported that the light between 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and the Lane Way has been completed.

It was resolved that Council be informed of the removal of sand from that portion of the Lyle Street to Robert Street area that is known as the Sunny Site Estate, and especially from that part out of which the new road (?) for that Estate is to be formed, that the Council be asked to take stringent steps to prevent further removals.

It was decided that members be notified by the hon treasurer of subscriptions due to this Association.
