There were present:

Mr Herbert in Chair. Mr Solomon, Vice President, in the Chair, Mrs Griffin, Miss Lightfoot, Assistant Secretary, Mr Jenkins, by invitation, Mr Griffin, Mr Poyett, and the hon. secretary.

Apologies for absence were received from Mrs Solomon, and Mr Fisher, hon treasurer.

The following recommendations to General Meeting were duly agreed upon:

1. That the Willoughby Municipal Council be urged to put forward and urge the desirability of holding the 1931 Exhibition on the headlands of Middle Harbour
2. That the Association's delegates to the Willoughby Municipality Progress Associations' Federation bring before that Federation the desirability of the St Leonards, -Victoria Avenue, -Roseville route for the proposed St Leonards to Manly railway.
3. That the Willoughby Municipal Council and the Main Roads Board be severally approached and asked to put Lyle Street in order, as per Motion 2 of the Proceedings of the Association on March 1st of the present year.
4. That the Willoughby Municipal Council, in view of the representation from the Electricity Department of the City Council that a very considerable guarantee on the part of consumers in Edinburgh Road and Tor Walk is essential to the extension of the present Electric Light Service, be asked to indicate its preparedness to furnish light to the district to lighten cost and also to meet the great need for illumination of the dangerous track.
5. That the Willoughby Municipal Council'scalled to the necessity for the immediate resumption of the foreshores of Middle Harbour along the lines of town policy re same.
