An apology was tendered and accepted on behalf of Mr Solomon for absence due to illness.

The minutes of the previous General Meeting were read, received, and confirmed.

Inwards Correspondence was read and received, and Outwards Correspondence was read and endorsed.

The Following motions were duly carried:

1. That the hon. Secretary forward a copy of the letter sent to Willoughby Municipal Council re the 1931 Exhibition, to the Prime Minister, and Mr Cliff Hay (sent also to the Premier (Mr Barin), Mr Hughes (Federal Member), Mr Sanders (State Member).
2. That Mr Herbert and Mr Solomon act as our delegate to the Federation for the coming year.
3. That the Federation fee be paid.
4. That notices of the Annual Meeting be sent to all members
5. That arrangements for the Annual Christmas Tree form part of the business of the Annual Meeting.
6. That Mr & Mrs Simmons of Taraina (?) Lyle Street, be elected members of the Association, and also Mr Pynor c/- Mrs Griffin, no 46 The Parapet, Castlecrag.

Federation Report: Mr Solomon reported that at the last meeting of the Federation, the Castlecrag route for the new railway was rejected as the Federation had already endorsed the acceptance of the Northbridge route; and also that the Federation had decided to recommend that Eris (?) Street be continue through to Lyle Street.
