SPECIAL MEETING: TRANSIT NORTH

A TALK BY DR J.B.GEROFI OF ENERSOL CONSULTING ENGINEERS

AT THE CASTLECRAG COMMUNITY CENTRE CORNER OF THE RAMPART and THE POSTERN 8.00 PM THURSDAY 12 MAY 1988

MOST OF OUR RESIDENTS WILL BE AWARE OF A PROPOSAL MADE BY WARRINGAH SHIRE COUNCIL AND SUPPORTED BY THE COUNCILS OF MANLY, MOSMAN AND WILLOUGHBY, FOR A LIGHT RAIL MASS TRANSIT SYSTEM LINKING THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT OF SYDNEY WITH NORTH SYDNEY, MOSMAN, MANLY AND WARRINGAH. THIS PROPOSAL KNOWN AS TRANSIT NORTH HAS BEEN BRIEFLY OUTLINED IN A PAMPHLET RECENTLY DELIVERED TO ALL RESIDENCES IN THE AREA. IF ADOPTED, THIS SCHEME WOULD BE OF SIGNIFICANT IMPORTANCE TO ALL WHO LIVE IN CASTLECRAG, SEAFORTH AND NORTHBRIDGE.

DR GEROFI IS A SENIOR PARTNER OF ENERSOL CONSULTING ENGINEERS, WHO IN ASSOCIATION WITH SOCIALDATA AUSTRALIA, BHP ENGINEERING AND BARCLAYS AUSTRALIA, CARRIED OUT THE STUDY. HE WILL ADDRESS OUR MEETING AND LATER ANSWER QUESTIONS.

THE STATE GOVERNMENT IS CURRENTLY RE-EXAMINING FREEWAY AND TRANSPORT OPTIONS FOR SYDNEY. RESIDENTS ARE CORDIALLY INVITED TO ATTEND THE MEETING, TO BETTER INFORM THEMSELVES OF THE POSSIBLE IMPLICATIONS OF THE TRANSIT NORTH PROPOSAL. THE MEETING WILL CLOSE AT 10 PM AND WILL BE FOLLOWED BY LIGHT REFRESHMENTS.
